Congratulations! It is my pleasure to inform you that your application to attend the 2016 REU Summer Program on Ubiquitous Sensing at the University of South Florida, in Tampa, Florida from May 24th to July 29th, 2016, has been accepted.

You will receive a total salary of approximately \$5000 paid in three installments for working full time in the assigned research project plus a meal stipend of approximately \$1200 paid in two installments. In addition, we will cover your travel expenses from and to your place of origin and lodging expenses on campus. We will make travel and lodging arrangements for you. You will be required to travel and arrive in Tampa on **Monday, May 23rd and return to your place of origin on Friday, July 29th, 2016**. Our first day of work will be Tuesday, May 24th, 2016 at 9 a.m.

Please bear in mind that it is mandatory that the student completes the entire program. In the event that you leave without completing the program, you will be responsible for all travel, meals, and lodging expenses.

If you accept the invitation, please include in your email the attached Personal Information and W9 forms completely filled out along with a proof of US citizenship or permanent residency (copy of your passport, permanent resident card, or birth certificate). **If we do not hear from you by this date, we will provide this opportunity to another applicant.**
